PURPOSE To ensure appropriate deduction of Provincial SUN dues.

SCOPE Members

POLICY STATEMENT Provincial SUN dues for each member will be 1.8% of regular salary, provided that each facility/agency at which the member works is subject to a signed initial collective agreement.

PROCEDURE SUN union dues shall not be deducted if a pay cheque only contains one or more of the following:

- a) Corrections issued resulting from errors in a month in which a member has already paid dues.
- b) LTD benefits.
- c) Statutory holiday off pay and payments associated with it (i.e. vacation).

Union dues shall be deducted from members receiving top-up payment for Workers' Compensation and Maternity/Paternity Leave Top-up.

The Union shall return, to a Local which does not have a signed, first collective agreement, Provincial and Local dues which are submitted to the Union by the Employer on behalf of each member. When a collective agreement is signed on behalf of such Local prior to the 15th of the month, the provincial portion of union dues shall be maintained by the Union from that month onwards. Where a collective agreement is signed on behalf of such Local after the 15th of the month, the provincial portion of union dues shall be maintained by the Union from the month following and onwards.
