Membership Policy 026-M-2007 outlines funding provided to external educational events and in some cases, provisions vary from event to event. The general funding provisions per event are outlined as below:

SFL/CLC Spring School	Maximum of 40 hours	Accommodation is included in registration fee, assigned shared accommodation	Round trip kilometrage for greater than 50 kms one way	Meals are included in registration fee
Prairie School for Union Women	Maximum of 40 hours	Accommodation is included in registration fee, assigned shared accommodation	Round trip kilometrage for greater than 50 kms one way	Meals are included in registration fee, except for Tuesday evening meal
SFL OH&S Conference	Income continuance or 8 hours/day for three days (inclusive of travel time)	Room sharing expected, member books own hotel	Round trip kilometrage for greater than 50 kms one way	Meal per diems do not cover meals provided by the event
