**PURPOSE** To provide financial assistance to students in RN and RPN education programs.

**SCOPE** Students in RN and RPN education programs

**POLICY STATEMENT** SUN recognizes the value of supporting nursing education.

**PROCEDURE**

1. Saskatchewan Union of Nurses Trust Award – University of Saskatchewan: 1 x \$1500
  - Open to students entering 2<sup>nd</sup> or 3<sup>rd</sup> year of the Bachelor of Science in Nursing degree program.
  - Selection will be based on financial need (75% weighting) and academic achievement (25% weighting), as determined by the Award Committee.
  - Recipient awarded by a Committee determined by the Dean, College of Nursing.
2. Saskatchewan Union of Nurses Saskatchewan Collaborative Bachelor of Science in Nursing Memorial Award: 1 x \$1500
  - Open to Saskatchewan Collaborative Bachelor of Science in Nursing Program, Year 1 or Year 2 students who are enrolled full-time at any location where the program is delivered.
  - Selection will be based on Financial Need (75% weighting), Academic Achievement (25% weighting).
  - Award selection by Saskatchewan Polytechnic Donor and Alumni Relations Office.

3. Saskatchewan Union of Nurses Psychiatric Nursing Memorial Award: 1 x \$1500
  - Open to Psychiatric Nursing Diploma program, Year 2 students who are enrolled full-time at Saskatchewan Polytechnic Wascana campus.
  - Selection will be based on: Financial Need (75% weighting), Academic Achievement (25% weighting).
  - Award selection by Saskatchewan Polytechnic Donor and Alumni Relations Office.
  
4. CFNU/SUN Scholarship: 1 x \$1000
  - One scholarship for 3<sup>rd</sup> or 4<sup>th</sup> year student of a registered nursing education program in Saskatchewan.
  - Emphasis on need as opposed to academic excellence. Preference will be given to a child of a SUN member. Applicant must submit a 500 word paper on “Unionism in Nursing.”
  - Selection is made annually by the Executive Committee. Information regarding the successful candidate is sent to CFNU who issues the scholarship.
  - Information and applications available on SUN’s website.

All awards are managed by the Educational Institutions as per the criteria set out by the SUN Memorial Scholarship Fund Trustees. The trustees are SUN First and Second Vice-Presidents, SUN Local 105 President and two members of the Fockler family.

Awards are subject to change following negotiations of the Terms of Reference with the Educational Institutions or changes to Canada Revenue Agency requirements.
