Question: What is the legislation, regulation, and requirements that apply to registered nursing practice in Saskatchewan? Where do I find more information?

Answer: As a registered nurse in Saskatchewan our profession arises from provincial legislation that has been delegated to professional regulatory bodies to enact, interpret, and enforce. Table 1 outlines the respective legislation, bylaws, and requirements that directly apply to becoming, being, and remaining a registered nurse in Saskatchewan.

The healthcare system, workplaces, and healthcare providers are further guided by additional legislation, regulation, and guiding documents enacted by both the provincial and federal governments. Tables 2 & 3 outline primary legislation and regulation that impacts and directs the system, workplace, and providers in their professional practice.

While not an exhaustive list, these documents provide the context and requirements to be met within the professional healthcare system. Additional legislation, regulation, or requirements may apply to some registered nurses, dependent on their professional practice, population served, and/or work environment.
